FINANCIAL AID

What types of aid are available at UNMC?

- ▶ **Scholarships** The application for UNMC scholarships is mailed with your letter of acceptance from the College of Nursing. The deadline to apply is 30 days from your date of acceptance. One application is used for all scholarship awards made by the College of Nursing. Not all scholarship awards are academic so we encourage you to apply.
- ▶ **Grants** To be considered for grant aid, students must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Grants are based on financial need and do not have to be repaid.
- ▶ **Federal Work Study** You must complete the FAFSA to be considered for Federal Work Study funds. If you are interested, mark this field on your UNMC application for Scholarships and Financial Aid.
- ▶ **Education Loans** You may be eligible to receive a variety of loans. Completing the FAFSA is the first step. Visit the financial aid website for more information.
- ▶ **Non-Resident Tuition Waivers**** The College of Nursing has a limited number of non-resident tuition waivers that allow non-residents to attend at resident rates. - ▶ **Graduate Assistantship/Advanced Education Nursing Traineeship** For more information; please contact the Graduate nursing office at (402) 559-4121.

How do I apply for financial aid at UNMC?

A packet of information will be included with your letter of acceptance from the College of Nursing. Return the scholarship application to the financial aid office within 30 days of your date of acceptance.

For Federal Aid consideration, students must complete the FAFSA. Remember to include the University of Nebraska Medical Center's institutional code. The code is 006895. If you have already filed a FAFSA, but did not include our school code, you can contact the financial aid office for assistance. You do not need to file another form.
