OPERATIONS TEAM CLEANS THE OUTSIDE OF THE SUIT BEFORE REMOVAL

02



MAINTAIN AIRWAY PROTECTION BY REMOVING MASK TOWARDS END OF DOFFING PROCESS

03



REMOVE PATIENT CARE GLOVES (IF WORN)

04



REMOVE TAPE AT TOP OF NECK AND OPEN SEAL ALONG ZIPPER

05



LOOSEN AND REMOVE BELT

06



REMOVE THE SUIT HOOD





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07 REMOVE TAPE SECURING OUTER PROTECTIVE GLOVES



08 REMOVE OUTER PROTECTIVE GLOVES



09 REMOVE SUIT TOUCHING ONLY INTERNAL SURFACES. DOFFING PARTNER SHOULD ONLY TOUCH EXTERIOR



10 SLIDE THE SUIT DOWN SO THE PERSON CAN SIT.



11 REMOVE TAPE AT THE TOP OF THE OUTER BOOTS



12 REMOVE THE OUTER BOOTS
