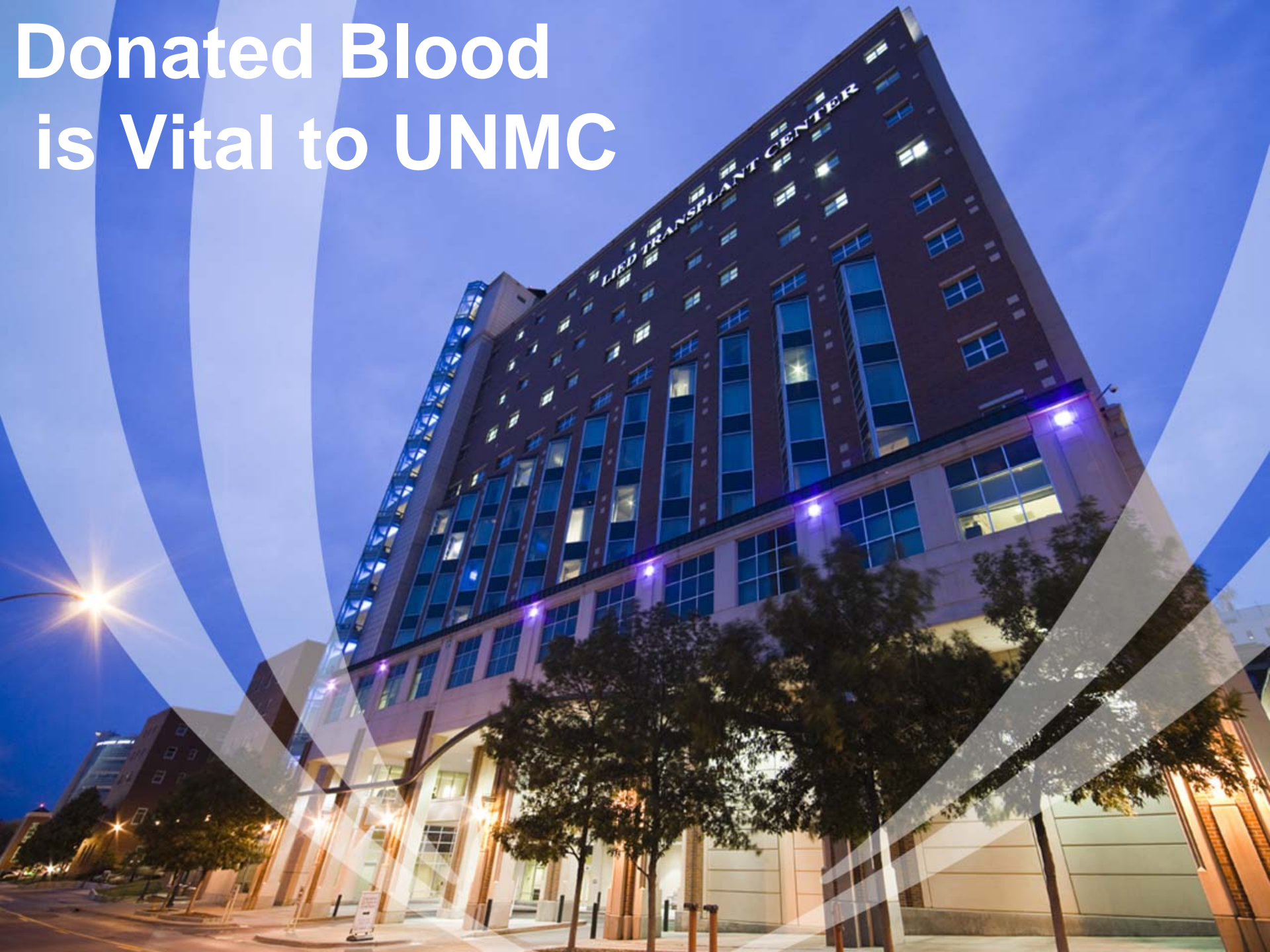


Donated Blood is Vital to UNMC

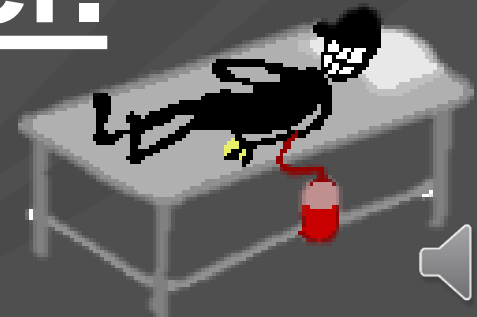
Blood donors can provide assistance to others that can literally mean the difference between life and death.
