NU produces 11,000 graduates annually.


Southeast Region: \$1.5 Billion (Districts 1,21,23,24,25,26,27, 28,29,30,32,46)


Southeast Region: \$662 million (Districts 1,21,23,24,25,26,27, 28,29,30,32,46)

Western Region: \$66 Million (Districts 42,43,44,47,48)



THE STATE OF NEBRASKA LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS


