

Our Commitment to Privacy

This privacy policy has been compiled to inform you about how your information is being used by the UNMC CON CNE website. Please read our privacy policy carefully to understand how your information is collected, used, protected, disseminated or otherwise handled.

The information collected about you is what you voluntarily choose to provide us via the online form and via cookies, as described herein.
