ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The presenting author is required to attend the ICG+P Meeting 2018. The presenting author should be the submitter of the abstract.

All abstracts must be submitted via the online abstract submission system using the following guidelines. Abstracts should be uploaded as a Word or PDF file.

Abstract must be in their final state, which will be reproduced from the online submission, so any errors will be printed as submitted. All listed authors must be in agreement of submitted work.

Accepted abstracts will be published in the conference book and made available to all registered participants in printed form.

Title Should be concise, but there is no maximum character limitation Bolded text Justified text

Author Listing

First, middle initial, and last name(s) with presenting author in bold text Associated affiliation(s), city, state, and country Justified text

Abstract Body

250 words maximum, not including title and author listing One paragraph maximum Text only – no graphics Justified text No headers No references or acknowledgements of financial support

Receipt of Abstract

The abstract submission system will provide a confirmation page as soon as you complete the submission process. Keep this for your files.

Selection

The ICG+P executive committee will make every effort to give oral presentations to investigators who have requested this format. However, preference for oral presentations will be given to pre- and post-doctoral trainees and selected junior faculty. The preliminary program will be available on the conference web site the week of September 24th, 2018.

Poster Size

Posters should be no more than 4' x 3'. Posters can be oriented either landscape or portrait.
